Dear Vendor:

On August 14, 2008, the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA) was signed into law. The CPSIA affects nearly all suppliers of both children's and non-children's products. The requirements are complex, so we strongly recommend that you review your obligations under the law with your own lawyers. We want to take this opportunity to advise you that we are aware of the many communications from the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) regarding product certification now required of any consumer product that is subject to a consumer product safety rule, ban, standard, regulation, or any Act enforced by the CPSC. The certificates must be issued by manufacturers, importers, and private labelers of consumer products sold in the United States to certify compliance with safety laws enforced by the CPSC.

We are reviewing the documents and will be advising you as we have more information to share.
